Subject: Update on application for renewal of land concession of an oil palm estate of Univanich Palm Oil PCL

**To: The President
The Stock Exchange of Thailand**

As we announced on 24 April 2013, Univanich Palm Oil PCL has submitted a petition to the Administrative Court of Nakhon Sri Thamarat, which seeks the court to order all related government organizations to complete consideration of the company's request for the renewal of part of Land Concession Certificate no. 76 dated 19 July 1985. The Administrative Court has accepted this petition which is now under the court's consideration.

The company also asked the Administrative Court to issue a temporary injunction, allowing the company to continue utilizing the concession area as usual until the Court makes a final judgment. That Petition is now under consideration by the Courts since 12 July 2013.

Pending a decision from the Court, on 24 July 2013 the company filed a Request for Urgent Protection with the Administrative Court in response to the movement of a number of people onto parts of the concession area. The Company currently awaits the Court's response to our Request for Urgent Protection, which response is expected in coming days.
